The Drake Law Review invites submissions for its Spring 2022 symposium issue in honor of the Drake Legal Clinic's 50th anniversary.

We seek Articles and Essays that broadly address the history of clinical legal education, current trends in clinical pedagogy and practice, and the future of experiential education in the legal academy. Submissions related to specific clinical subject areas or clinical projects are also welcomed.

Eligibility and Submission Details

The Drake Law Review invites submissions from faculty, practitioners, jurists, and others engaged in experiential education. Authors participating in the symposium issue will be invited to attend and present their papers at the Midwest Clinical Conference at Drake Law School on November 5-7, 2021.

Interested authors are asked to submit an abstract by **5:00 p.m. May 28, 2021** to law.review@drake.edu. Invitations to publish will be made by June 1, 2021. Essays should be approximately 10,000-15,000 words in length and articles should be approximately 20,000-30,000 words in length. The deadline to submit a paper is **July 31, 2021**.
