

## Submissions to ECGAR (2020-21)

The *Emory Corporate Governance and Accountability Review* (ECGAR) is currently accepting submissions to be considered for publication in our next volume (8). Submissions are accepted and reviewed on a rolling basis until the end of September. ECGAR is a publication that welcomes articles and submissions that touch on corporate governance.

All submissions are subject to a review process, which includes several steps prior to being chosen for publication (outlined below in Review Process). Submissions must respect the conditions stated below.

**Topic & Content:** ECGAR explores the relationship between the corporation and its stakeholders in the United States and abroad. This online, student-run publication seeks to identify the relevant laws and regulations impacting corporations and how changes to the legal landscape will further affect them. We accept a broad range of topics touching on all legal fields, but on some level, submissions must discuss the relationship between law and corporations (corporate governance).

**Length:** We publish submissions in a number of formats, including blog posts, opinion essays and responses, symposium pieces, surveys, book reviews, and traditional, full-length law review articles. Submissions range from ~15-60 pages. We do not have a strict page or word requirement for any submission, as we understand varying topics require varying lengths.

**Style & Citation Format:** ECGAR adheres to *The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation* (20th ed. 2015). Submissions need not be received in this format; however, footnotes should be. Articles selected for publication, however, will be edited to conform to this standard.

**Deadline:** Articles may be submitted year-round; however, articles seeking publication in the upcoming publication (volume 8) should be received by the end of September. **Submission Process:** Please email your submission in a word document to Luke Meyerson for the quickest response time and most direct contact to ECGAR.

**Review Process:** Once all articles are received by the end of September, the executive board along with our academic advisors will read and review all submissions. We will hold a vote to decide which submissions are on track to be published. Once a decision has been made, we will notify the authors. Our executive board will discuss with authors any editorial changes prior to publication if needed, and a formal offer to publish the submission will be made contingent upon successful completion of the editorial process. Subsequently, our editorial staff will edit footnotes, due diligence, and formatting ensure conformity with the Bluebook guidelines and the publication will go out by January.
