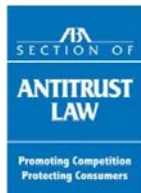

On June 11, 2014, China's State Administration for Industry and Commerce (SAIC) released the 8th Draft of its Anti-Monopoly Law/IP Rules.
