Call for Works-in-Progress Proposals

Deadline for Works-In-Progress Proposals: March 22, 2016

The Planning Committee for the 2016 Midwest Clinical Legal Education Conference invites you to submit works-in-progress proposals for this year's conference, which will take place from Thursday evening, October 6 to mid-day Saturday, October 8, 2016 at the University of Tulsa College of Law in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

The Committee invites submissions of works-in-progress by new and experienced scholars on all topics and at all stages of development, including fully drafted papers as well as half-baked ideas. Presenters will be provided an opportunity to introduce their projects and discussants will be appointed to facilitate an exchange of ideas regarding each work. Presenters with works-in-progress at later stages of development will have an opportunity to share their drafts and receive more detailed feedback from discussants and participants. The work-in-progress topic does NOT need to relate in any way to the conference theme of *Teaching for Our Times*.

SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS

Presenters should submit a brief abstract of their work-in-progress (250 words maximum) by e-mail to midwest-clinic-conference-2016@utulsa.edu no later than March 22, 2016. Please use the attached proposal coversheet format for works-in-progress proposals. Once WIP participants have been identified, timelines for submission of drafts or outlines will be worked out among discussants and presenters in advance of the conference.
