**ORDER**

Upon consideration of the Government's Motion for Modification of the Trial Schedule (ECF No. 410) and the Opposition thereto (ECF No. 414), the Motion will be DENIED. This case arose in 2013. As a result of extensive investigation by both sides, the Court determined, and the Government conceded, that significant material and false testimony was admitted at the Defendant's trial. The Court, therefore, granted a new trial. Taking into consideration the Defendant's right to a speedy trial, the preparedness of the Government to re-try this case, and the Court's schedule, the Government's delay and postponement request, and the basis of such request, would not meet the ends of justice, would be fundamentally unfair to the Defendant's constitutional rights, and are not compelling enough to outweigh the public interest in a speedy trial.
