Licensed to practice law by the Bar associations of Delaware, Florida and Pennsylvania, Wolfe is a former U.S. Air Force Intelligence Officer, whose 11-year career in the military included a stint as sole U.S. Air Force Target Intelligence Specialist responsible for operational planning and readiness support of U.S. military air and ground operations during the 1989 invasion of Panama that removed Gen. Manuel Noriega from power.

Curtis Wolfe began his legal career in 1995, upon receipt of a Juris Doctorate degree from the University of Iowa College of Law, where he graduated with distinction. He clerked with the Supreme Court of Delaware prior to joining the Wilmington, DE-based office of Philadelphia law firm Stradley, Ronon, Stevens & Young as a Litigation Associate in 1995; from 1996-98, he served as an Associate in the Business & Finance Group at multi-practice, multi-regional Philadelphia-based firm Ballard, Spahr, Andrews & Ingersoll, one of the largest legal firms in the United States.

In 1998, Wolfe relocated to Florida where he joined the leading Miami-based international law firm of Steel Hector & Davis where he became a Partner and over the next six years developed a diverse corporate transactional practice, with a focus on mergers and acquisitions, start-up company financing, franchising and intellectual property.

In 2004, Wolfe left Steel Hector to become the General Counsel of Ener1 Group, Inc., a Fort Lauderdale based private equity firm that founded Ener1, Inc. (HEV), a lithium-ion battery developer focused on batteries for hybrid electric and plug-in electric vehicles, as well as other start-up and acquisition companies.

In 2006, Wolfe founded mRevolution, LLC, a multi-million dollar, online media company that provides cutting-edge technology solutions for the affiliate marketing, lead generation and ad serving marketplaces. Based in Boca Raton, FL, mRevolution is the holding company for WhoCanISue.com. During this time, Wolfe created the business model for WhoCanISue.com for which he has filed a provisional patent application, as well as other innovative online solutions.

Since 2007, Wolfe has also served as General Counsel & Director at TOT Energy, Inc, a diversified energy company focused on the acquisition, exploration, development, production, and marketing of crude oil and natural gas from Russia and other former Soviet Republics.

In addition to his JD degree, Wolfe holds a Bachelor's in Integrated Studies from Weber State University in Ogden, Utah, as well as two Associates Degrees from the Air Force Community College, in Intelligence Operations and Criminal Justice.
